



DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN KIAMAINA WARD

Education

- Bursary Program
Disbursement delayed due to approval bottlenecks, but expected to roll out soon.
- Scholarship Support
Continued full sponsorship for needy students within the sub-county.
- Vocational Training Support
 - County-funded capitation of KES 30,000 per trainee covering tuition, meals, and exams.
 - Additional bursary support available for trainees enrolling in VTCs.
- ECDE Feeding Programme
Ongoing provision of fortified porridge under the *Lishe na Mama Uji Programme* to support early childhood nutrition and learning.

Infrastructure

- Road Improvement Works (Imarisha Programme)
Grading and gravelling of roads (targeting approximately 14 km per ward), with rollout expected across wards including Kiamaina following the rainy season.

Trade and Cooperatives

- Wezesha Fund Access
 - Enterprise Fund loans for small-scale traders at 8% interest.
 - Cooperative Revolving Fund loans at 6% interest for registered cooperatives.
- Enterprise Fund Disbursements (Sub-County Level)
Financial support issued to local groups, strengthening small business and cooperative activity.

Health

- Maternity Wing Construction (Bahati Sub-County Hospital)
Ongoing construction (about 59% complete) of a new maternity wing to improve maternal and child healthcare access.
- Dundori Health Centre Upgrade
Construction of a modern kitchen to support maternity services and patient care.
- Social Health Authority (SHA) Registration Drive
Ongoing push to enroll residents for improved access to affordable healthcare services.
