Geographic & Economic Profile

- Total area: **7,498 KM²**
- Population: **2,352,202 (KNBS, 2022)**
- Contributes **5.2%** to National GDP (*KNBS, Gross County Report 2024*)
- Gross County Product (2023/24): **€5,256,654,140**

Key Environmental Challenge

- Rapid urban growth leading to increased waste generation
 - Need for sustainable, circular economy solutions
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Slide 3 – Integrated Material Recovery Facility (MRF)

Waste Management Snapshot

- 5 Disposal Sites: *Giotto (Nakuru), Naivasha, Mai Mahiu, Molo, Njoro*
- Waste Collection: **>60% coverage**
- Organic Waste: **>65%** of total
- Waste Generated: **>200 tons daily**

Identified Gap:

Current disposal sites nearing capacity (Giotto site expires by 2030)

→ Necessity for a **sustainable waste processing solution**

Slide 4 – MRF Project Progress

Current Status & Phases

1. **Project Identification** – Giotto site lifespan assessment
2. **Pre-Feasibility Study** – 5 viable options identified; preliminary E&S plan done
3. **Feasibility Study** – Requirements identification underway
4. **Implementation** – 25-acre parcel of land secured for MRF

Project Timeline (2026–2030)

Components:

- Dirty MRF
 - In-vessel composting
 - Waste-to-energy plant
 - Engineered landfill

Phase 1 (Estimated KES 99.3 Million):

- Electrical & Solar Works – 19M
- Security & Caretaker House – 4.5M
- Twin Changing Rooms – 20M
- Kitchen & Hostel Equipment – 50M
- Drainage, Irrigation, Solarization – 6.8M

Phase 2 (Estimated KES 785M):

- Twin Hostels (200 beds) – 200M
- Modern Kitchen – 200M
- Tartan Track – 250M
- Swimming Pool – 50M
- Gym & Admin Block – 60M
- Pavilions (4 × 25M) – 100M
